 - A) Great American Smoke-Out, November/TFW- The next day will be the GASO and two events will be held in Dixie County, the Dixie County School Board and the Tri-County Library. Both locations will share Tobacco Free Workplace materials and 3 Ways to Quit (Quit & Tell) promotional materials.
 - B) SWAT Reports
 - i) Ruth Rains Middle School SWAT Report (Richard Whittington) Shared that they held a meeting and is planning a booth at a basketball game.
 - ii) Dixie County High School SWAT Report (Lindsey Whittington) Shared that they have held several events at the school and is planning a Movie Night on the Football field that will include a smoke free/tobacco free movie.
 - iii) Charter Community SWAT Report (Johnnie Grimes) were unable to attend this meeting but sent a report that they have held a meeting this quarter and plan to hold an event prior to the Christmas break.
 - C) Point of Sale Policy Presentation (Melanie Anderson) Shared that the partnership chair and co-chair will be conducting a Counter Tools Florida Store Assessment on tobacco retailers in Dixie County that hold a retail tobacco licenses.
 - D) Day Care Center/Secondhand Smoke Event-The partnership member discussed how to reach the day care parents by either by holding an event. The DCHS SWAT officers shared that the Movie Night will be showing two movies, one that will be age appropriate for day care age students and that they could

include Tobacco Free Partnership of Dixie County as one of the sponsors so that they can get the second hand smoke message during the event and include 50 free tickets to the sponsorship so that they can be handed out at the day care centers to encourage attendance of the target audience.

- E) Smokeless Tobacco- Two Youth read the current Florida Youth Tobacco Survey data on smokeless use in Dixie County compared to the state average. Another youth read the smokeless tobacco facts that need to be shared in the community to assist in changing the social norm.
- F) Mary Jean Koll came to speak about her quit experience with all 6 steps with finishing up with Quit & Tell in honor of the Great American Smoke Out.
